Requirements/Skills needed

- High school education;
- Diploma in the use of CNC machines (asset);
- 12 to 24 months in a similar position;
- Experience in the steel industry (asset);
- Proficiency in reading blueprints;
- Ability to read blueprints and use the imperial metric system and to use various measuring tools;
- Ability to use cranes, hoists and lifting hands;
- Ability to communicate adequately and learn on the job;
- Responsible, versatile and autonomous;
- Physical fitness required to work long hours on your feet;
- Working knowledge of health and safety regulations in a manufacturing plant.

Tasks and responsibilities

- Operate a plasma cutting table (take reference and make the cut);
- Ensure quality of cut parts, identify them by number and file them;
- Handle with the help of a bridge crane the steel from the racks to the tables as well as the scrap from the tables to the racks;
- Make sure to have the right consumables and the right cutting gases;
- Validate the wear of consumables and detect overconsumption;
- Change and connect gas cylinders in a safe manner;
- Maintain the cutting table (structure and cutting head) and filters;
- Perform all other tasks related to the production sector.
